





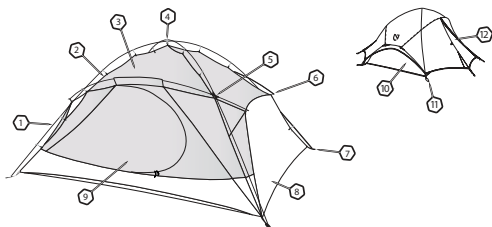
### **NEMO MISSION**

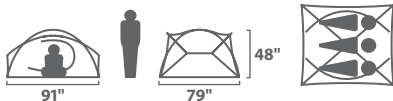

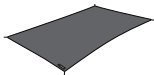

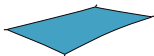


## Optional Accessories

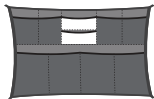
1. **Footprint:** The Footprint is a 70D abrasion-resistant nylon fabric ground sheet perfectly sized to fit underneath your tent. The fabric is PU coated for waterproofness (10,000 mm). The Footprint reduces wear and tear on your tent floor from contact with the ground.



2. **Pawprint™:** The Pawprint™ is a removable liner perfectly sized to fit inside your tent. It has the dual function of protecting your tent floor from boots and paws, and of adding serious comfort. The Pawprint™ is made of a machine-washable brushed polyester that is very soft to the touch. Place your sleeping pads between the Pawprint™ and floor to help them stay in place. With a clean, soft Pawprint™ under you, you might be able to save some weight and travel with a lighter sleeping bag or blanket.



3. **Gear Caddy:** A Gear Caddy with Light Pockets™ and multiple organizing compartments is included with every Losi 3P™ tent. A second optional Gear Caddy can be added for even more storage at the opposite end of the tent. The Light Pockets™ diffuse light from your headlamp to cast an even glow over the whole tent.



4. **Gear Loft:** The Losi 3P™ Gear Loft adds additional overhead storage without compromising floor space or elbow room. The mesh Gear Loft is perfect for drying clothes or stashing gear for quick access. The Gear Loft also has two mesh gear storage pockets and two Light Pockets™ which diffuse light from your headlamp to cast an even glow throughout the tent interior.

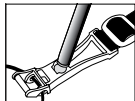

Includes GREEN™ anodized DAC Featherlite® NSL poles, Gear Caddy, roll-up style stuff sack, stakes, and repair kit. Optional Footprint, Pawprint™, extra Gear Caddy, and Gear Loft are available.

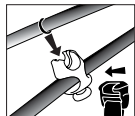
### LOSI 3P™ Innovations

**1. Superior Hardware:** Several innovative pieces of hardware are used to increase the ease of setup and strength of Losi 3P™.

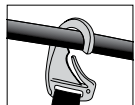
The DAC Jake's Foot corner anchor system makes tent setup faster and easier. The main poles attach to the anchors by ball and socket. When the fly is attached, the Jake's Feet act as cantilevers to pull the corners of the inner tent closer to the ground. The Jake's Feet also allow you to set up your fly and poles without the inner tent to create a convenient tarp/shade shelter.



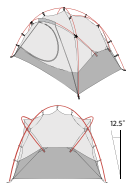
The Intersection Hubs and center Swivel Hub lock the poles together at each location where they cross. This makes the tent much stronger and resistant to wind forces.



The unique shape of the DAC pole clips makes them easy to use and more durable than standard pole clips.



**2. Unique Pole Configuration:** The ridge poles on Losi 3P™ run the long direction on the tent and terminate above the ground. This design adds significant interior volume and provides nearly vertical walls on all sides of the tent. The steep walls mean you can sit straight up almost anywhere inside Losi 3P™.



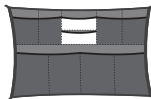
**3. On the Fly Configuration:** Ditch your inner tent for a light weight tarp structure created by your fly, poles, and footprint. This is ideal for a sunny day at the beach or on those backpacking trips where every ounce counts. Setup is simple with Jake's Feet corner anchors and Velcro® wraps on the fly.



**4. Dual Entries/Vestibules:** Two doors and two vestibules eliminate jostling for position and gear storage. Both vestibules can be used in multiple configurations depending on weather conditions and your need for privacy. For maximum ventilation on sunny days, tie back the doors or take the fly off completely. Leave the doors open for a slight breeze on cooler or wetter nights. When rain and snow are coming down hard, close the entire vestibule for full protection.



**5. Gear Caddy with Light Pockets™:** The Gear Caddy is a detachable storage unit that can be installed on either end of the tent. It is made of mesh and has compartments of all different sizes to fit glasses, books, or clothes. The Gear Caddy also includes two Light Pockets™. Most headlamps have a focused beam of light and hanging your lamp inside your tent can be frustrating. This special pocket holds your headlamp and has a light diffusing fabric that helps cast an even glow throughout the tent.

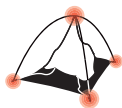

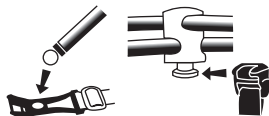
## 1 Stake Corners (optional)

Secure the corner anchors by pounding the stakes into the ground with a rock or hard object. If the ground is too hard, trap the stakes under a rock or another heavy object.



## 2 Jake's Feet and Center Swivel

Press the ball ends of poles into the fittings (Jake's Feet) at the corners of the inner tent. Attach the black clip at the center of the mesh to the clear swivel between the main poles.



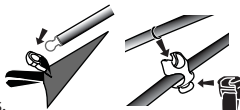
## 3 Clips and Pole Sleeves

Attach the inner tent to the main poles with clear clips. Slide the ridge poles through the side pole sleeves keeping the ridge poles on the outside of the main poles.



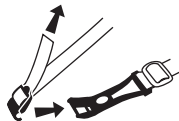
## 4 Secure Ridge Poles

Snap ends of ridge pole in ball caps on sides of tent. Align plastic rings on ridge pole above the intersection hub and press down into place. Attach black clips on the mesh tent to the hub bottoms.



## 5 Attach Fly

Clip the corners of your tent fly to the Jake's Feet. Proper tension ensures maximum water shedding and wind resistance. Pull firmly on the adjustable corner anchors.
