



How to Replace Pole Segments: Tips and Tricks

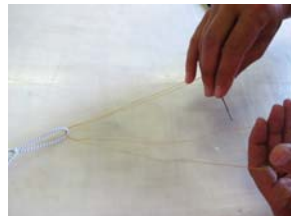
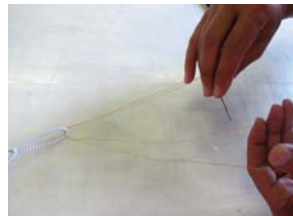
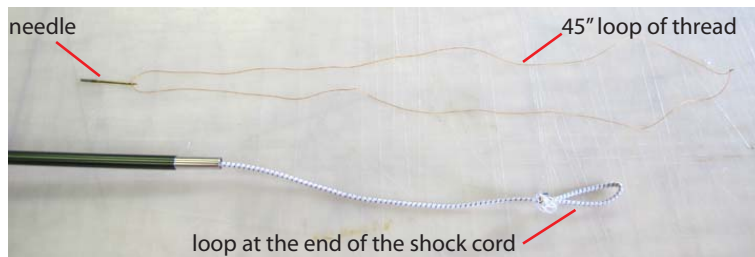
1. Unscrew ball cap from the pole end nearest to the damaged segment. Next, unhook the ball cap from shock cord.



2. Slide off damaged segments (keep segments and hub in order). When you get to the center pole hub, pull the shock cord out from the center hub to continue to slide off the damaged segment.

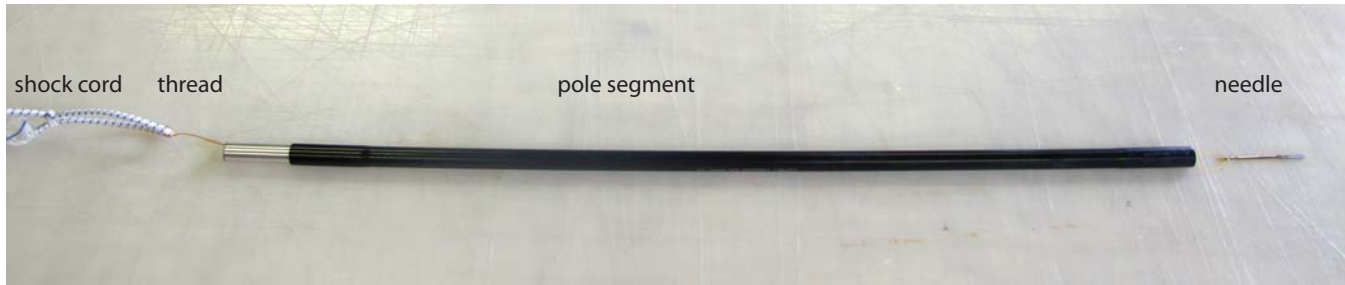


3. Take the loop at the end of the shock cord, and loop the thread and needle around the shock cord.





4. Use the needle to re-thread the cord through the new pole segments.



Pull gently but firmly as the knot from the shock cord works its way through the pole segment (don't prick yourself with the needle).

Slide one replacement segment on, then feed the cord back through the pole center hub. Then continue to refeed the remaining segments and hub.

5. Hook the ball cap back onto the shock cord loop.



6. Remove the thread and needle from the cord loop, and screw the cap back onto the pole.

7. Go camping!
